§ 122-1. Injuries to trees prohibited.

No person shall in any way mutilate, cut down, injure or destroy any shade or ornamental tree upon the streets, sidewalks or parks within the Village without a permit from the Mayor.

§ 122-2. Penalties for offenses.

Any person committing an offense against the provisions of § 122-1 shall be guilty of a violation under the Penal Law and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punishable by a fine of not more than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) or by imprisonment for not more than fifteen (15) days, or both.
