Village of Cold Spring **Historic District Review Board** 85 Main Street, Cold Spring, New York 10516 Monthly Meeting 7-12-17

The Village of Cold Spring Historic District Review Board held its regular monthly meeting at the Cold Spring Village Hall, 85 Main Street on Wednesday July 12, 2017.

Members Present: Chair Al Zgolinski and board members: Sean Conway, Carolyn Bachan and Andrea Connor. Kathleen Foley was absent. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 pm.

OLD BUSINESS

3 Furnace Street, nationally-listed area of the Historic District 48.8-6-35. Bill Sussman, owner, represented by James Hartford (River Architects.) Exterior modifications include: rear addition, siding, trim and decorative elements.

- J. Hartford presented plans and elevations revised per the previous HDRB workshop.
- C. Bachan made a motion to classify the project SEQR Type II because it is an existing structure. S. Conway seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.
- HDRB discussed the historic suitability of the proposed brackets and trim. Of concern were the capitals on the ionic columns. Board members voiced a desire for a simpler "bullseye" design.
- HDRB consensus is that the nature of the application will not require a public hearing.
- Applicant to make the modifications identified by the HDRB and to return on July 26, 2017 (when the HDRB will vote.)

NEW BUSINESS

8 Locust Ridge, locally-listed area of the Historic District 49.5-2-27. Hass Murphy and D. Botnick. Replacement of cedar shake siding and replacement of two windows.

- Hass Murphy presented the project: a 100-year old house. Existing shakes are in a deteriorated condition and rather that piecemeal replacement; applicant seeks to replace with cedar ship-lap siding on all sides, except for the dormers which would have cedar shakes.
- Applicant presented window cut sheets (Marvin Windows) and pictures of adjacent houses.
- C. Bachan made a motion to classify the project SEQR Type II because it is an existing structure. S. Conway seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.
- C. Bachan made a motion to approve the application as amended. S. Conway seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

4 B Street, Nationally-listed area of the Historic District. Installation of solar panels.

• Chris Patak (Hudson Solar) appeared on behalf of the applicant and presented a photo-rendering of what the completed installation will look like. Panels to be installed close to and parallel to the roof. Wiring to be gathered under the panels and combined into a single run to the electrical equipment in the basement. Wire run propose to be adjacent to existing Central Hudson wiring.

- C. Bachan made a motion to classify the project SEQR Type II because it is utility work. S. Conway seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.
- HDRB discussed alternate locations of wire run (from roof to basement.)
- S. Conway made a motion to approve the application as submitted. C. Bachan seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

224 Main Street, Nationally-listed area of the Historic District, R. Hoffman, owner 49.5-2-30.1. Restoration of roof, window replacements, installation of AC condenser demolition of existing fence and its replacement.

- Applicant presented the project, including photos, elevations and cut-sheets.
- S. Conway made a motion to classify the project SEQR Type II because modification to the façade only. C. Bachan seconded and the motion passed unanimously.
- HDRB had no comment on the roof restoration
- HDRB members expressed concern about the new window's framing and proportional appearance in relation to the façade.
- HDRB members expressed concern that replacement of all the windows as proposed would significantly change the appearance of the windows, a character defining feature.
- Existing 6'-0" fence around the pool is a non-conforming existing condition. Applicant stated their willingness to repair fence rather than replace (.
- HDRB proposed an enclosure for the AC condenser and discussed the size and style of the fence that will surround it.
- . C. Bachan made a motion to approve the roof renovation as submitted. S. Conway seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.
- A. Connor made a motion to approve location of the AC condenser as amended. C. Bachan seconded and the motion passed unanimously.
- HDRB requested applicant to revise the exterior elevations showing the proposed windows locations and look for a window which would have a smaller profile The Board will review on July 26, 2017.

BOARD BUSINESS

HDRB discussed draft of history portion of updated design guidelines (prepared by K. Foley.) Consensus is favorable, though minor edits are to be expected.

ADJOURNMENT

S. Conway made a motion to adjourn the meeting. C. Bachan seconded and the meeting was adjourned at 10:45pm.
