CODE UPDATE REVIEW

The Board continued its review of Chapter 134 – Zoning. During the review three motions were made.

Mayor Merandy made a motion to allow home occupations in accessory buildings under the same conditions as for home offices as described in Village Code Section 134-16.G (4) (b). Trustee Miller seconded and the motion passed 3-2, with Trustees Early and Murphy voting against.

Mayor Merandy made a motion to retain the listing of professions permitted in the current definition of Home Profession Office, specifically physicians, dentists, surgeons, etc. as currently identified in the Village Code. Trustee Miller seconded and the motion passed 3-2, with Trustees Early and Murphy voting against.

Trustee Early made a motion to retain the Village Code 4'-0" fence height limitation. Trustee Murphy seconded and the motion was defeated 2-3 with Mayor Merandy and Trustees Miller and Voloto voting against.
