# Trustees Meeting 2-5-19

The Village of Cold Spring Board of Trustees held a meeting at the Cold Spring Village Hall, 85 Main Street on Tuesday February 5, 2019 at 7:30pm. Present were: Mayor David Merandy and Trustees Marie Early, Lynn Miller, Frances Murphy and Steve Voloto.

# REQUEST BY Z. MARKEY FOR REIMBURSEMENT (FULL OR PARTIAL) OF EXPENSES RELATED TO OBTAINING CDL

During the discussion it was noted that:

- Previously employees learned the requisite skills needed to obtain a CDL, rather than taking a class
- Board members are concerned about setting a precedent
- CDL is not a Village requirement for the position
- Markey will receive a pay raise as a result of obtaining a CDL
- Village has no program to reimburse employees for classes taken, except to allow paid time to take the class
- Consensus of all Board members is not to reimburse Markey for this expense.

# INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION

During the discussion it was noted that:

- The Independence Day committee will need to be reformed. An ad will be placed in the paper requesting volunteers and an organizational meeting is scheduled for 2/26/19
- The Mayor will contact Nick Groomsbridge regarding sponsorship of the fireworks. If he is not amenable, another sponsor will need to be found
- There was concern about excessive heat last year
- The number of vendors selling the same items will be limited
- Should the parade be abandoned and only the music and fireworks retained? Should there only be fireworks?
