VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

**ARTICLE I
General Provisions**

§ 126-1. Definitions of words and phrases.

- A. The words and phrases used in this Chapter shall, for the purposes of this Chapter, have the meanings respectively ascribed to them by Article I of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York.
- B. The following words and phrases, which are not defined by Article I of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York, shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them in this section for the purposes of this Chapter:

CROSSWALK ZONE – The no-parking, setback area on either side of a crosswalk, as indicated by street striping, which widens sightlines at crosswalks to meet NY State crosswalk safety standards. [Added __-__-2023 by L.L. __-2023]

METERED PARKING ZONE – A paid, and during some hours unpaid, public parking area designated by ordinance where a vehicle may be temporarily parked and allowed to remain for the period of time indicated on the Parking Meter Kiosk, Mobile Parking Meter App, and/or signage. [Added __-__-2023 by L.L. __-2023]

MOBILE PARKING METER APPLICATION OR PARKING METER KIOSK – Any application notated on street parking and Municipal Parking Lot signage for parking meter payments, or mechanical device or meter, not inconsistent with this article, placed or erected for the regulation of parking by authority of this article. [Added __-__-2023 by L.L. __-2023]

MUNICIPAL PARKING LOT – A piece of property owned by the Village of Cold Spring where multiple parking spaces exist, and which can only be accessed by entering the parking lot through a driveway entrance.

PARKING METER SPACE – Any space within a Metered Parking Zone which has a Parking Meter Kiosk or is located in an area controlled by a Parking Meter Application and which is duly designated for the parking of a single vehicle by lines painted or otherwise durably marked upon the curb or the surface of the street adjacent to or adjoining parking meter signage. PARKING METER AREA – Any and all streets, or Municipal Parking Lots, set aside under the provisions of this article for the installation and operation of parking meters and upon

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which Parking Meter Kiosks and or Moblie Parking Meter Application signage have been installed and are in operation. [Added __-__-2023 by L.L. __-2023]

RESIDENT PERMIT PARKING AREA – (See Ch. 127 Residential Parking Program) – A street parking area designated by ordinance where a resident vehicle with a permit, or service personnel or guest vehicles with temporary permits, may be parked and allowed to remain for the period of time indicated on the adjacent street signage. [Added __-__-2023 by L.L. __-2023]

STOP INTERSECTIONS –Intersections with one or more entrances at which stop signs are erected. [Added __-__-2023 by L.L. __-2023]

STREET PARKING – Parking spaces, whether parallel, diagonal, or perpendicular, on the side of a public street or roadway, that is directly accessible by vehicles from that street or roadway.

THROUGH STREETS –Every street, or portion thereof, at the entrances to which vehicular traffic from intersecting streets is required by law to stop before entering or crossing that street, and where stop signs are erected as provided in this Chapter. [Added __-__-2023 by L.L. __-2023]

§ 126-7

§ 126-2. Authority to install traffic control devices.

The Village of Cold Spring shall install and maintain traffic control devices when and as required under the provisions of this Chapter, to make effective the provisions of this Chapter, and may install and maintain such additional traffic control devices as the Board of Trustees may deem necessary to regulate, warn or guide traffic under the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York, subject to the provisions of §§ 1682 and 1684 of that law.

§ 126-3. Implementation of provisions.

The provisions of this Chapter shall be implemented by the adoption of regulations by the Board of Trustees or an officer or agency authorized by it pursuant to § 1603 of New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law and § 20-2002 of New York State Village Law. Such regulations shall be placed in the appropriate schedule established by this Chapter for the recording of such regulations. Such schedules shall be attached to and form a part of this Chapter, and a violation of any regulation contained in said schedules shall be deemed a violation of this Chapter. **ARTICLE II
Traffic Regulations**

§ 126-4. One-way roadways.

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The streets or parts of streets described in Schedule I (§126-28) are hereby designated as one-way streets, and vehicles shall proceed only in the direction indicated.

§ 126-5. Prohibited turns at intersections.

No person shall make a turn of the kind designated (left, right, all) at any of the locations described in Schedule II (§ 126-29).

§ 126-6. U-turns.

The turning of vehicles so as to proceed in the opposite direction (otherwise known as a “U-turn”) is hereby prohibited on those streets designated in Schedule III (§126-30).

§ 126-7. Through Streets.

The streets or parts of streets described in Schedule IV (§126-31), are hereby designated as Through Streets, and stop signs shall be erected at entrances thereto as indicated. All vehicles shall comply with said signs. See New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law, Art 1, § 149. **[Amended 11-04-2021 by L.L. 35-2021]**

§ 126-8. Stop Intersections.

The intersections described in Schedule V (§ 126-32) are hereby designated as Stop Intersections and stop signs shall be erected as indicated. All vehicles shall comply with said signs.

§ 126-9. Yield intersections.

The intersections described in Schedule VI (§126-33) are hereby designated as yield intersections, and yield signs shall be erected as indicated. All drivers of vehicles shall comply with said signs.

§ 126-10. Speed regulations.

The maximum speed at which vehicles may proceed on or along any roadways that are not state roads within the Village is hereby established at twenty-five (25) miles per hour, except that the speed limit for vehicles proceeding on or along those streets or parts of streets described in Schedule VII (§ 126-34) shall be as indicated in said schedule. See NY State Vehicle and Traffic Law Art. 39 §1643.

**ARTICLE III
Parking, Standing and Stopping**

§ 126-11. Statutory authority; scope.

This Article is enacted pursuant to the authority of § 1640 of New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law. The restrictions herein are in addition to those set forth in Article 32 of the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law. [Amended 11-04-2021 by L.L. 35-2021]

§ 126-12. Application of Article.

The provisions of this Article shall apply except when it is necessary to stop a vehicle to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or official traffic control device.

§ 126-13. Parking within marked spaces.

Wherever a space shall be marked off on any street for the parking of an individual vehicle, every vehicle there parked shall be parked within the lines bounding such space. It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle across any line or marking of a parking space or in such position that the vehicle shall not be entirely within the area designated by such line or markings.

§ 126-14. No parking at any time.

The parking of vehicles is prohibited at all times on those streets or parts of streets described in Schedule VIII (§126-35).

§ 126-15. Seasonal parking restrictions.¹

- A. No motor vehicle, trailer or wheeled conveyance shall be allowed or permitted to stop, unattended by a licensed driver, or to stand or park, on any Village road or highway or on any town, county or state highway within the Village during the winter season between dates and hours to be set by the Village Board by regulation. (See Schedule IX, §126-36)
- B. The purpose of this section is to facilitate the orderly and unobstructed passage of snow plowing and snow removal equipment during each winter season.

§ 126-16. Stopping and standing prohibited.

The stopping and standing of vehicles is hereby prohibited in the locations described in Schedule X (§126-37).

§ 126-17. Parking prohibited certain hours.

¹ Editor's Note: Seasonal parking regulations, originally adopted November 21, 1977, as L.L. No. 6-1977, were carried forward into this chapter under the provisions of No. 2.1978 adopted September 12, 1978.

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The parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited in locations described in Schedule XI (§ 126-38) during the times indicated.

§ 126-18. Limited time parking.

Unless a notification has been made to the Cold Spring Police Department by the vehicle owner, a vehicle can park on a public street only 14 days before it must be moved. Any vehicle that remains on a public street parking area beyond that limit shall be declared an abandoned vehicle and may be subject to removal by the Cold Spring Police Department (ref. § 126-19.1. Removal of vehicles parked in prohibited areas or abandoned.) **[Added _ - -2023]**

- A. The parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited in the locations described in Schedule XII (§126-39) for a longer period of time than that designated. It shall be unlawful to cause, allow or permit any vehicle to be parked overtime or beyond the period of legal parking time established. **[Amended 11-04-2021 by L.L. 35-2021]**
- B. When a vehicle remains parked for a period in excess of that allotted, a new period of parking will be deemed to have commenced for purposes of constituting a separate offense under this Article, and each succeeding period of time equal to that originally allotted shall be deemed to constitute a separate offense. For example, if parking is limited to two (2) hours and a vehicle remains parked in excess of two (2) hours, a new period of parking shall be deemed to commence at the end of the two (2) hour period, and each succeeding two (2) hour period during which said vehicle remains parked shall constitute a separate offense.

§ 126-18.1. Parking at Chestnut Street Shopping Center. [Added 8-12-80 by L.L. No. 2-1980; Amended 2/14/2017 by L.L. No. 1-2017]

- A. The parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited at all times within the marked and posted fire lane area in front of the retail shops in the shopping center known as the “Chestnut Street Shopping Center,” commonly known as the “Foodtown Shopping Center” at the intersections of Chestnut Street and Benedict Road in the Village of Cold Spring. **[Amended 5-27-03 by L.L. 2003-01; 2-14-17 by L.L. 1-2017; 11-04-2021 by L.L. 35-2021]**
- B. Any authorized law enforcement officials shall have the authority to remove and store any vehicle parked in such area during snowstorms, floods, fires or public emergencies or found unattended in such area where such vehicle constitutes an obstruction to traffic or where such parking is prohibited. Actual and reasonable charges for such removal and storage shall be paid by the owner or operator of any such vehicle so removed or stored. The sanctions imposed by these sections shall be in addition to those authorized under Article IV, Enforcement and Penalties, of this Chapter.

§ 126-18.2. Handicapped parking. [Added 8-11-81 by L.L. No. 2-1981]

A. The Village Clerk of the Village of Cold Spring is hereby designated as the agent for the issuance of special parking permits to handicapped residents of the Village of Cold Spring in accordance with the following:

- (1) Such permit shall be in the form and style as may be prescribed by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, pursuant to § 1203-a (Parking Permits for Handicapped Persons) of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York.
- (2) Application for special permit shall be on forms prescribed for said purpose by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles and in accordance with the procedures and guidelines established by said Commissioner and the State Advocate for the handicapped.

B. Handicapped parking in the B-2, B-3, and B-4 zoning districts. **[Amended 11-04-2021 by L.L. 35-2021] [Amended __-__-2023 by L.L. __-2023]**. Whenever a business or facility in the B-2, B-3, or B-4 zoning districts have filed a written request with the Village Board of the Village of Cold Spring to regulate traffic in parking areas, pursuant to New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law, § 1640-a, or whenever a business or facility in the B-2, B-3, or B-4 zoning districts are otherwise required to do so pursuant to law, such business or facility in the B-2, B-3, or B-4 zoning districts shall provide parking spaces to be used solely by vehicles displaying parking permits for handicapped persons. Such parking spaces shall be provided in accordance with the following:

- (1) The spaces shall be located in the general parking area of the business or facility in the B-2, B-3 or B-4 zoning districts and shall be in close proximity to an entrance to one (1) or more of the stores in the businesses or facilities in the B-2, B-3 or B-4 zoning districts. **[Amended 11-04-2021 by L.L. 35-2021]**
- (2) Each designated space shall be marked by a sign which clearly indicates that such spaces are reserved for the use of persons possessing a special parking permit for handicapped persons.

C. Parking spaces. **[Added 12-6-1985 by L.L. No. 1-1985;² [Amended 6-12-1990 by L.L. No. 1-1990; 2-14-2017 by L.L. 1-2017]**

- (1) There shall be provided on specific public streets in the Village of Cold Spring parking spaces to be used solely by vehicles displaying parking permits for handicapped persons in accordance with provisions of Subsection A of this section and/or permits issued under the provisions of § 1203-a or 404-a of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York. **[Amened __-__-2023 by L.L. __-2023]**

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- (2) There shall be provided under the provisions of this section eleven (11) parking spaces at the following locations: **[Amended 3-12-2013 by L.L. 2-2013; Amended 2-14-2017 by L.L. No. 1-2017] [Amended __ - __-2023 by L.L. __-2023]**

- (a) One (1) space on the south side of Main Street 20 feet east of the crosswalk between 87 and 91 Main Street, Cold Spring. **[Amended 11-04-2021 by L.L. 35-2021]**
- (b) One (1) space on the north side of Main Street 20 feet west of the crosswalk at the intersection of Main Street and Garden Street. **[Amended 11-04-2021 by L.L. 35-2021]**
- (c) One (1) space in front of 17 Kemble Avenue, Cold Spring.
- (d) One (1) space in municipal street parking at corner of Kemble Avenue and The Boulevard. **[Amended 11-04-2021 by L.L. 35-2021] [Amended _____ by L.L. ____-2023]**
- (e) One (1) space in front of 238 Main Street, Cold Spring.
- (f) One (1) space in front of 241 Main Street, Cold Spring.
- (g) One (1) space in front of 2 Main Street, Cold Spring. **[Added 2-14-2017 by L.L. No. 1-2017]**
- (h) Two (2) spaces in Fair St Municipal Parking Lot. **[Added _____ by L.L. ____-2023]**
- (i) One (1) space on the south side of Main Street 20 feet east of the crosswalk in front of 161 Main Street. **[Added _____ by L.L. ____-2023]**
- (j) One (1) space in front of 215 Main Street. **[Added _____ by L.L. ____-2023]**
- (3) These parking spaces shall be clearly identified for the designated use by handicapped persons, which designation shall include permanently installed above-grade signs which display the international symbol of access and use by handicapped persons and may include the use of blue painted lines or markings.

D. Prohibitions.

- (1) No person shall park or stand a motor vehicle in any parking space designated for parking for handicapped persons without displaying on the vehicle dashboard or sun visor on the driver's side or on the vehicle license plate a duly issued handicapped parking permit. **[Amended 11-04-2021 by L.L. 35-2021]**

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- (2) No person to whom a permit has not been issued shall use a handicapped parking permit to park a motor vehicle in a designated handicapped parking space, except while transporting a handicapped person to whom such permit has been issued.

§ 126-18.3. Trailers. [Added 5-9-95 by L.L. 95-3 and Amended 11-13-2012 by L.L 2-2012]

- A. Except as provided below, trailers, as defined in Section 156 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of this State as well as and including house trailers, mobile homes, boat trailers, semi-trailers, moving trailers, vending trailers, shall not be parked on any Village street, including public parking areas or private streets where parking is controlled by the Village, unless the trailer is at all times hitched to a vehicle.
- B. Exceptions. Trailers that are not hitched to a vehicle may be parked on any Village street under any of the following circumstances:
 - (1). When a permit to vend has been granted by the Village for the trailer;
 - (2). When such parking is done in conjunction with on-going construction for which permits are in place;
 - (3). When such parking is of a trailer providing transportation of seasonal or temporary recreational vehicles or equipment and notice of such parking has been provided in writing to the Village Clerk at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance. This trailer can be left in place for no longer than forty-eight (48) hours. **[Amended 11-04-2021 by L.L. 35-2021] [Amended ____, by L.L. No. __-2023]**

§ 126-18.4. Tour Buses [Added __-__-2023 by L.L. __-2023].

- A. Tour buses over twenty-four (24) feet in length may only pass over and disembark on the following Village of Cold Spring streets to promote safe and uninterrupted traffic flow: Main St./Rte. 301, Fair St., Chestnut St., Morris Ave., and Rte. 9D. Reference § 126-42. Restricted Parking. for bus temporary parking area.
- B. Tour Buses may only park for limited periods of up to three (3) hours in the parking area designated “Bus Parking” and marked with signage on the south-west side of Chestnut Street across from the Chestnut Ridge senior housing development.

§ 126-18.5. Resident permit parking. [Added ____, by L.L. No. __-2023]

- A. The parking of vehicles without resident parking permits is hereby prohibited in the locations and during the times described in Schedule XIV (§126-43).
- B. Vehicles parked in Residential Permit Parking Areas during the restricted hours will be ticketed or towed and stored. Each day a vehicle is parked without permit in a Residential Parking Permit Area will count as a separate offense and shall be ticketed by law enforcement as such or removed at owner’s expense.

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- C. The Village has the authority to sell permits and set fees in Residential Permit Parking Areas as set forth in the Master Fee Schedule. The fees are subject to change by resolution of the Village Board of Trustees.

§ 126-18.6. Parking meters. [Added __-__-2023 by L.L. __-2023]

- A. The Village and its enforcement agencies have the authority to enforce and collect parking fees, as outlined in the Master Fee Schedule, and as communicated through the Park Mobile Application and Parking Meter Kiosks in Metered Parking Zones.
- B. General. Street Parking and Municipal Parking Lots that are metered for a Metered Parking Zone are intended only for the parking of resident and visitor vehicles that are licensed, registered and insured year-round. Parking is available to the public with time limitations as noted in § 126-39 Schedule XII, during metered and non-meter hours. No buses or campers are permitted due to the size limitations unless specifically permitted by the Village Board.
- C. Exceptions. Village employees, police, and emergency service vehicles are exempt from parking meter fees for the explicit purpose of conducting official Village business. Commercial delivery vehicles are exempt from parking meter fees for deliveries servicing businesses in Metered Parking Areas.
- D. Metered street parking shall have assigned parking zones numbered on Parking Meter Area signage for the operation of the Mobile Parking Meter Application. Parking Meter Kiosks are located in the general vicinity of each Meter Parking Area and accept payments by license plates only for vehicles adjacent to the general parking area of each Parking Meter Kiosk. The Mobile Parking Meter Application and Parking Meter Kiosks will accept credit cards, debit cards or other such payment methods as may be designated by the Village Board.
- E. Fees. Metered fees are communicated through the Mobile Parking Meter Application (Parking Meter Application link is listed on adjacent street signage), Parking Meter Kiosks, and are listed in the Master Fee Schedule. See Master Fee Schedule. The Village Board of Trustees will set the fee amount from time to time by adopting a resolution setting the fee in the Master Fee Schedule.
- F. Hours and days of operation. Metered hours are communicated through the Mobile Parking Meter Application (Parking Meter Application is listed on adjacent street signage), Parking Meter Kiosks, and are listed in the Master Fee Schedule. Metered street parking hours shall be set by the Village Board of Trustees and hours of fee collection shall be communicated to the public by the Mobile Parking Meter Application and can be found in the Master Fee Schedule. The hours are subject to be adjusted by a resolution by the Village Board of Trustees.
- G. Expired Parking. It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle or to permit a vehicle to remain parked in any metered street parking space without paying the proper payment heretofore designated or for longer than the period for which the proper payment was paid.
- H. Enforcement. The provisions of this section shall be enforced by the Cold Spring Police Department and mutual aid agencies of the Village of Cold Spring pursuant to §126-19 of this Chapter.

**ARTICLE IV
Enforcement and Penalties****§ 126-19. Enforcement by Police Department.**

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It shall be the duty of the Cold Spring Police Department and mutual aid agencies to enforce the provisions of this Chapter. [Amended 11-04-2021 by L.L. 35-2021] [Amended - -2023 by L.L. No. -2023]

§ 126-19.1. Removal of vehicles parked in prohibited area and abandoned vehicles. [Added 3-25-86 by L.L No. 1-1986] [Amended _-_-2023 by L.L. No. _-2023]

Any authorized law enforcement official shall have the authority to remove and store any vehicle which has been abandoned (ref. § 126-18.B Limited time parking.) or parked in prohibited or unauthorized areas or illegally parked during snowstorms, floods, fires or public emergencies, or found unattended in areas where such vehicle constitutes an obstruction to traffic or where such parking is prohibited. Actual and reasonable charges for such removal and storage shall be paid by the owner or operator of any such vehicle so removed or stored. The sanctions imposed by this section shall be in addition to those authorized under Article IV, Enforcement and Penalties, of this Chapter.

§126-20. Enforcement procedure.

All proceedings for enforcement and court proceedings shall be governed by the New York State Criminal Procedure Law and by the provisions of the Vehicle and Traffic Law.

§ 126-21. Traffic infractions.

It is a traffic infraction for any person to violate any of the provisions of this Chapter. Every person convicted of a violation of a traffic infraction shall be punished by a fine and/or imprisonment as determined by New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law.

§ 126-22. Penalties for speeding violations.

Every person convicted of a violation of § 126-10 of this Chapter shall be punished by a fine and/or imprisonment as determined by New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law. [Amended 11-04-2021 by L.L. 35-2021]

§ 126-23. Penalties for parking violations. [Amended 11-04-2009 by L. L. 2009-03]

A. Parking offenses. The following fines will be authorized by the presiding Village Justice on the scheduled hearing date for a sole parking offense. Failure to appear to said hearing or failure to pay within the prescribed time frame established below shall result in an increased fine as authorized by the Village Justice on the scheduled hearing date in conformity with the table of fines set forth in this section:

- (1) Where the sole offense charged is a parking offense, the person so charged shall have the option of appearing in the Village Court before the presiding Village Justice or may plead guilty to such offense by mail by remitting to the Court, on or before the return date on the ticket, the Official Village of Cold Spring traffic summons ticket together with the following fine set forth in Table 1 Column (A) of this section;

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- (2) Where the sole offense charged is a parking offense and the person so charged shall have failed to appear in the Village Court before the presiding Village Justice on the return day of the ticket or within thirty (30) days thereafter, then the person may plead guilty to such offense by mail by remitting to the Court, on or before sixty (60) days after the return date on the ticket, the Official Village of Cold Spring traffic summons ticket together with the fine established in Table 1 Column (B) of this section;
- (3) Where the sole offense charged is a parking offense and the person so charged shall have failed to appear in the Village Court before the presiding Village Justice on the return day of the ticket or within sixty (60) days thereafter, then the person may plead guilty to such offense by mail by remitting to the Court, on or before ninety (90) days after the return date on the ticket, the Official Village of Cold Spring traffic summons ticket together with the fine established in Table 1 Column (C) of this section;

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- B. Two (2) or More Violations. However, any person who shall have been convicted of two (2) or more violations of Article III of this Chapter within an eighteen-month (18 month) period shall not have the option of following the procedure set forth in Subsection A hereof but must appear before the Court, and such person, upon conviction, shall be subject to the imposition of a fine within the limits set forth in § 126-24 hereof.

§ 126-24. Additional penalty provisions.

- A. Every person convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this Chapter for which another penalty is not provided shall be punished by a fine or by imprisonment according to New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law. **[Amended 4-27-99 by L.L. 1999-03; Amended 11-04-2021 by L.L. 35-2021]**

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- B. Failure to pay a fine as hereby provided or to appear in court voluntarily in answer or response to a ticket or summons will subject the operator or owner of such vehicle to a warrant for arrest and the imposition of such penalties as the law may provide.
- C. In addition to any other penalties or fines imposed for the violation of the Chapter, any authorized law enforcement official shall have authority to impound or to secure in place by means of a “boot” or similar detention device, any vehicle parked upon any public street in the Village of Cold Spring for which report has been made from the Village Justice Court to the Village Police Department that delinquent parking tickets totaling two hundred dollars (\$200) or more have been issued and have not been paid, satisfied, or otherwise disposed of. **[Added 7-12-2011 by L.L. 2-2011]**
- D. The owner of a vehicle removed by an authorized tow company shall be responsible to pay, in addition to the ticket issued by the Village of Cold Spring, the full amount charged by that tow company. **[Added 7-12-2011 by L.L. 2-2011; Amended 11-04-2021 by L.L. 35-2021]**
- E. The owner of a vehicle secured in place under § 126-24 C. shall be responsible for payment of the charges for securing of the vehicle, in the amount of fifty dollars (\$50), in addition to the delinquent parking tickets. **[Added 7-12-2011 by L.L. 2-2011; Amended 11-04-2021 by L.L. 35-2021]**
- F. Vehicles which are impounded or secured in place under § 126-24 C. and § 126-24 D. shall be retained in custody or shall be continually secured until such time that said tickets for violations as well as all removal and storage charges have been paid, satisfied, or otherwise disposed of. **[Added 7-12-2011 by L.L. 2-2011; Amended 11-04-2021 by L.L. 35-2021]**

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ARTICLE V
Miscellaneous Provisions

§ 126-25. When effective.

- A. Except those parts, if any, which are subject to approval under § 1684 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York and § 46 of the Highway Law of the State of New York, this Chapter and any regulations adopted hereunder shall take effect as provided by law.
- B. Any part or parts of this Chapter and any regulations adopted hereunder which are subject to approval under § 1684 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law and § 46 of the Highway Law of the State of New York shall take effect from and after the day on which approval in writing is received from both the New York State Department of Transportation and the New York State Department of Public Works.

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§ 126-26. Severability.

If any Article, section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or provision of this Chapter shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such adjudication shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the Article, section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or provision thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

§ 126-27. Repealer.

All prior laws, ordinances, regulations and rules or parts of such of this Village regulating traffic and parking, except Local Law No. 6 of 1977,³ are hereby repealed, except that this repeal shall not affect or prevent the prosecution or punishment of any person for any act done or committed in violation of any ordinance, regulation or rule hereby repealed prior to the taking effect of this Chapter.

§ 126-41. Parking in Municipal Parking Lots. [Amended 4-12-2016 by L.L. 2-2016; 6-29-2021 by L.L 02-2021]

- A. General. The Municipal Parking Lots (the “Lots”) located on Fair Street and New St. are intended for the use of resident and visitor parking of licensed, registered and insured vehicles year-round. No buses or campers are permitted due to the size limitations unless specifically permitted by the Village Board. [Amended __-__-2023 by L.L. __-2023]
- B. The Lots shall have outlined parking spaces numbered with appropriate signs, together with proper signage for the operation of the Mobile Parking Meter Application. The Mobile Parking Meter Application and Parking Meter Kiosks will accept credit cards, debit cards or other such payment method as may be designated by the Village Board. [Amended __-__-2023 by L.L. __-2023]
- C. Fees. Any person desiring to park any vehicle within such Municipal Lots shall pay via the Parking Meter Kiosk, Mobile Parking Meter Application on their smart phone or by calling the toll free number shown on the signage and following the direction thereon for the time desired. [Amended __-__-2023 by L.L. __-2023]
- D. Hours and days of operation. The Municipal Lots shall operate 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, except from November 15th through April 15th between the hours of 9 p.m. and 8 a.m. to allow for mandatory off-street parking during the winter months.
- E. Expired Parking. It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle or to permit a vehicle to remain parked in any Municipal Lots parking space without paying the proper payment heretofore designated or for longer than the period for which the proper payment was paid.
- F. Enforcement. The provisions of this section shall be enforced by the Cold Spring Police Department and mutual aid agencies of the Village of Cold Spring pursuant to §126-19 of this Chapter.
