Setting a Date and Time for a Public Hearing on Proposed Local Laws Amending Chapters 126 and 127 of the Village Code

The following resolution was offered by _____ for adoption and seconded by _____, to wit:

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Cold Spring seeks to update the Village Code by amending Chapter 126 (Residential Parking Program) and Chapter 127 (Vehicle and Traffic) and set a time and place for a public hearing to consider such amendments.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Village Board hereby determines that it will be the lead agency with respect to the review of the proposed local law (the "project") in accord with New York State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") and part 617 of the regulations implementing SEQRA, since there are no other agencies that have the authority to approve the project; and let it be further

RESOLVED, that a public hearing be held by the Village Board in order to receive comments and suggestions regarding the proposed amendment and addition to the above listed Chapters and to receive any comments concerning the potential adverse environmental impacts of the proposed legislation in accord with SEQRA, on Wednesday October 11 at 7:00 pm at Village Hall, 85 Main Street, Cold Spring, NY; and let it be further

RESOLVED, that the Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause said public notice of said hearing to be given as provided by law.

FEE SCHEDULE:

Effective 1-1-2019 \$8.00 per-foot per-day, beginning and ending at 12 midnight when the Vessel does not remain docked for the duration. For the purposes of clarification: all Vessels shall pay the per-foot fee; vessels are permitted to be docked for a maximum of 45 minutes to permit passengers to embark/disembark.

Effective 1-1-2019, \$12.00 per-foot per day, beginning and ending at 12 midnight when the Vessel remains docked for the duration.

Applicant is required to remove any refuse resulting from their visit before leaving.

* Mooring bollards and/or cleats are not to be utilized by applicant to slow or turn vessels under power.

* As part of this application the owner/operator must provide the Village of Cold Spring a liability insurance policy naming the Village of Cold Spring as an additional insured on said policy. The policy shall have limits of \$1,000,000.00 for any one injury and \$2,000,000.00 for any one event and be written by or through an insurance company licensed by the State of New York.

* The undersigned does hereby agree to pay for any and all damages to equipment or property of the Village of Cold Spring used by said organizations, members, guests, or visitors.

* The undersigned does hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Village of Cold Spring from any and all claims, suits, or demands and any expenses incurred by said Village for investigation, legal fees, or otherwise, which arise out or are connected with the Village facility applied for herein and said Village shall be held harmless and indemnified regardless of whether the acts are the fault of the applicant or the Village. The applicant is responsible for determining if depth of water is sufficient for the docking of their vessel.

* Loud amplified music will not be permitted without the written permission of the Village Board.

* Applicant will not allow swimming from their vessel while docked.


* The Vessel Owner/Operator is responsible for ensuring that the passengers are informed of applicable boating safety procedures and that all appropriate safety equipment is available for all passengers.

* The Vessel Owner/Operator is responsible for the enforcement of all safety procedures.

* The Vessel Owner/Operator is responsible for facilitating the safe transfer of passengers to and from the vessel.

* This is a revocable permit subject to change.

Dear Mayor Foley and Commanding Officer Burke,

Re: Cold Spring Turkey Trot 2023

The Cold Spring Turkey Trot is a wonderful village tradition which ran from 2010 until 2021 each Thanksgiving morning. It is a 5km family fun run which, from a modest start of a couple of dozen runners, grew to over 100 community members over the years. The former organizers of the race (under Megan Cotter's leadership to raise funds for the Haldane Faust Spirit Award) no longer wish to organize this event and have approached The Haldane School Foundation (HSF) about continuing this community fundraiser.

HSF feels that there is an opportunity to continue the tradition under their own leadership. What's more, in doing so they would continue to raise funds for Haldane and its students. HSF respectfully asks the village and the Cold Spring Police Department to support this proposal for this and future years.

The HSF Turkey Trot committee is poised to work out the race details and to mobilize volunteers once approval is granted. Preliminary discussions have centered on the following areas.

Time and Location:

The proposed date is November 23rd (Thanksgiving Day) from 9:00am to approximately 9:45am. The route would start on the Haldane School running track and move through the village down to the gazebo and finish back on the running track. We feel that this would center the race on the school, allow for adequate parking, and minimize the number of road crossings. The school superintendent's permission is being sought simultaneously.

Safely and Liability:

HSF with its 17 trustees can provide a number of volunteers for route marking and general wayfinding assistance on race day. We would default to the commanding officer of the Cold

Spring Village Police Department for guidance on road crossing, and are willing to work with Putnam County REACT. First aid coverage would be provided at the finish line through a volunteer EMT. HSF will provide the insurance certificate the village requires for this event.

Publicity:

Marketing for this event will be largely through social media. A few posters will be placed strategically around the village and notes may be sent home with Haldane school children. We would ask that any approval of this request be shared with The Current and PCNR so that they may pick up the story and help promote this charitable event.

Please do not hesitate to reach out with whatever questions you have. We would be happy to present to the trustees in person as well.

Please let us know if the trustees require anything more for us to continue with the planning of this event
