

Description of changes to Chapter 0059 (Littering):

Corrected General References.

Changes to conform to Code Chapter convention.

Corrected punctuation.

Changes to some words and terms to improve understandability (e.g., changed “putrescible” to “decayable”).

Deleted “and sold to the public” from definition of “Newspaper”.

Consolidated “commercial handbill” and “noncommercial handbill” into “Handbill”.

Simplified definition of “Rubbish”.

Added “or animals” to conditions under which Litter can be deposited.

Removed vehicle wheels or tires as a method for depositing litter.

Added “river” to list of public waters.

Added requirement for permit for handbills; referenced Chapter 104.

Added “private carting services” as a collection agency.

Clarified time when containers are to be removed from Village property.

Renumbered “Deposit Restricted” from 59-22 to 59-19, renumbered “Severability” from 59-20 to 59-21, and renumbered “Repealer” from 59-21 to 59-22.
