# **VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC**

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[HISTORY: Adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Cold Spring 9-12-1978 as L.L. No. 2-1978. Amendments noted where applicable.]

§ 126-5

## ARTICLE I General Provisions

### § 126-1. Definitions of words and phrases.

- A. The words and phrases used in this Chapter shall, for the purposes of this Chapter, have the meanings respectively ascribed to them by Article I of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York.
- B. The following words and phrases, which are not defined by Article I of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York, shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them in this section for the purposes of this Chapter:

MOBILE PARKING METER APPLICATION - An application on a smart phone or accessible via a toll-free number which enables a person to pay to park in a parking meter zone upon entering the vehicle's license plate number, a method of payment, and the duration of time parking is desired or allowed for that zone. [Added 6-29-2021 by L.L. 2-2021]

OFFICIAL TIME STANDARD - Whenever certain hours are named herein or on traffic control devices, they shall mean the time standard which is in current use in this state.

## § 126-2. Authority to install traffic control devices.

The Village of Cold Spring shall install and maintain traffic control devices when and as required under the provisions of this Chapter, to make effective the provisions of this Chapter, and may install and maintain such additional traffic control devices as the Board of Trustees may deem necessary to regulate, warn or guide traffic under the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York, subject to the provisions of §§ 1682 and 1684 of that law.

## § 126-3. Implementation of provisions.

The provisions of this Chapter shall be implemented by the adoption of regulations by the Board of Trustees or an officer or agency authorized by it pursuant to § 1603 of New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law and § 20-2002 of New York State Village Law. Such regulations shall be placed in the appropriate schedule established by this Chapter for the recording of such regulations. Such schedules shall be attached to and form a part of this Chapter, and a violation of any regulation contained in said schedules shall be deemed a violation of this Chapter.

# **ARTICLE II Traffic Regulations**

§ 126-4. One-way roadways.

The streets or parts of streets described in Schedule I (§126-28) are hereby designated as one-way streets, and vehicles shall proceed only in the direction indicated.

### § 126-5. Prohibited turns at intersections.

No person shall make a turn of the kind designated (left, right, all) at any of the locations described in Schedule II (§ 126-29).

## § 126-6. U-turns.

The turning of vehicles so as to proceed in the opposite direction (otherwise known as a "U-turn") is hereby prohibited on those streets designated in Schedule III (§126-30).

## § 126-7. Through streets.

The streets or parts of streets described in Schedule IV (§126-31), are hereby designated as through streets, and stop signs shall be erected at entrances thereto as indicated. All vehicles shall comply with said signs. See New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law, Art 1, § 149

## § 126-8. Stop intersections.

The intersections described in Schedule V (§ 126-32) are hereby designated as stop intersections, and stop signs shall be erected as indicated. All vehicles shall comply with said signs.

#### § 126-9. Yield intersections.

The intersections described in Schedule VI (§126-33) are hereby designated as yield intersections, and yield signs shall be erected as indicated. All drivers of vehicles shall comply with said signs.

#### § 126-10. Speed regulations.

The maximum speed at which vehicles may proceed on or along any streets or highways within the Village is hereby established at thirty (30) miles per hour, except that the speed limit for vehicles proceeding on or along those streets or parts of streets described in Schedule VII (§126-34) shall be as indicated in said schedule.

# ARTICLE III Parking, Standing and Stopping

## § 126-11. Statutory authority; scope.

This Article is enacted pursuant to the authority of § 1640 of New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law. The restrictions herein are in addition to those set forth in Article 32 of the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law.

## § 126-12. Application of Article.

The provisions of this Article shall apply except when it is necessary to stop a vehicle to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or official traffic control device.

### § 126-13. Parking within marked spaces.

Wherever a space shall be marked off on any street for the parking of an individual vehicle, every vehicle there parked shall be parked within the lines bounding such space. It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle across any line or marking of a parking space or in such position that the vehicle shall not be entirely within the area designated by such line or markings.

## § 126-14. No parking at any time.

The parking of vehicles is prohibited at all times on those streets or parts of streets described in Schedule VIII (§126-35)

## § 126-15. Seasonal parking restrictions.<sup>1</sup>

- A. No motor vehicle, trailer or wheeled conveyance shall be allowed or permitted to stop, unattended by a licensed driver, or to stand or park, on any Village road or highway or on any town, county or state highway within the Village during the winter season between dates and hours to be set by the Village Board by regulation. (See Schedule IX, §126-36.)
- B. The purpose of this section is to facilitate the orderly and unobstructed passage of snow plowing and snow removal equipment during each winter season.

#### § 126-16. Stopping and standing prohibited.

The stopping and standing of vehicles is hereby prohibited in the locations described in Schedule X (§126-37).

### § 126-17. Parking prohibited certain hours.

The parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited in locations described in Schedule XI (§ 126-38) during the times indicated.

### § 126-18. Limited time parking.

- A. The parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited in the locations described in Schedule XII (§126-39) for a longer period of time than that designated. It shall be unlawful to cause, allow or permit any vehicle to be parked overtime or beyond the period of legal parking time established.
- B. When a vehicle remains parked for a period in excess of that allotted, a new period of parking will be deemed to have commenced for purposes of constituting a separate offense under this Article, and each succeeding period of time equal to that originally allotted shall be deemed to constitute a separate offense. For example, if parking is limited to two (2) hours and a vehicle remains parked in excess of two (2) hours, a new period of parking shall be deemed to commence at the end of the two hour period, and each succeeding two hour period during which said vehicle remains parked shall constitute a separate offense.

# § 126-18.1. Parking at Chestnut Street Shopping Center. [Added 8-12-80 by L.L. No. 2-1980; Amended 2/14/2017 by L.L. No. 1-2017]

- A. The parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited at all times within the marked and posted fire lane area in front of the retail shops in the shopping center known as the "Chestnut Street Shopping Center," commonly known as the "FoodTown Shopping Center" at the intersections of Chestnut Street and Benedict Road in the Village of Cold Spring. [Amended 5-27-03 by L.L. 2003-01; 2-14-17 by L.L. 1-2017]
- B. Any authorized law enforcement officials shall have the authority to remove and store any vehicle parked in such area during snowstorms, floods, fires or public emergencies or found unattended in such area where such vehicle constitutes an obstruction to traffic or where such parking is prohibited. Actual and reasonable charges for such removal and storage shall be paid by the owner or operator of any such vehicle so removed or stored. The sanctions imposed by these sections shall be in addition to those authorized under Article IV, Enforcement and Penalties, of this Chapter.

## § 126-18.2. Handicapped parking. [Added 8-11-81 by L.L. No. 2-1981]

A. The Village Clerk of the Village of Cold Spring is hereby designated as the agent for the issuance of special parking permits to handicapped residents of the Village of Cold Spring in accordance with the following:

- (1) Such permit shall be in the form and style as may be prescribed by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, pursuant to § 1203-a of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York.
- (2) Application for special permit shall be on forms prescribed for said purpose by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles and in accordance with the procedures and guidelines established by said Commissioner and the State Advocate for the handicapped.

## B. Handicapped parking in the B-2, B-3 and B4-A zoning districts

Whenever a business or facility in the B-2, B-3 or B4-A zoning districts have filed a written request with the Village Board of the Village of Cold Spring to regulate traffic in parking areas, pursuant to New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law, § 1640-a, or whenever a business or facility in the B-2, B-3 or B4-A zoning districts are otherwise required to do so pursuant to law, such business or facility in the B-2, B-3 or B4-A zoning districts shall provide parking spaces to be used solely by vehicles displaying parking permits for handicapped persons. Such parking spaces shall be provided in accordance with the following:

- (1) The spaces shall be located in the general parking area of the business or facility in the B-2, B-3 or B4-A zoning districts and shall be in close proximity to an entrance to one (1) or more of the stores in the businesses or facilities in the B-2, B-3 or B4-A zoning districts.
- (2) Each designated space shall be marked by a sign which clearly indicates that such spaces are reserved for the use of persons possessing a special parking permit for handicapped persons.

# C. Parking spaces. [Added 12-6-1985 by L.L. No. 1-1985;<sup>2</sup> [Amended 6-12-1990 by L.L. No. 1-1990; 2-14-2017 by L.L. 1-2017]

(1) There shall be provided on specific public streets in the Village of Cold Spring parking spaces to be used solely by vehicles displaying parking permits for handicapped persons in accordance with provisions of Subsection A of this section and/or permits issued under the provisions of § 1203-a or 404-a of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York.

- (2) There shall be provided under the provisions of this section seven (7) parking spaces at the following locations: [Amended 3-12-2013 by L.L. 2-2013; Amended 2-14-2017 by L.L. No. 1-2017]
  - (a) One (1) space in front of 91 Main Street, Cold Spring.
  - (b) One (1) space in front of 116 Main Street, Cold Spring.
  - (c) One (1) space in front of 17 Kemble Avenue, Cold Spring.
  - (d) One (1) space in front of 34 Kemble Avenue, Cold Spring.
  - (e) One (1) space in front of 238 Main Street, Cold Spring.
  - (f) One (1) space in front of 241 Main Street, Cold Spring.
  - (g) One (1) space in front of 2 Main Street, Cold Spring. [Added 2-14-2017 by L.L. No. 1-2017]
- (3) These parking spaces shall be clearly identified for the designated use by handicapped persons, which designation shall include permanently installed above-grade signs which display the international symbol of access and use by handicapped persons and may include the use of blue painted lines or markings.

#### D. Prohibitions.

- (1) No person shall park or stand a motor vehicle in any parking space designated for parking for handicapped persons without displaying on the vehicle dashboard or sun visor on the driver's side or on the vehicle license plate a duly issued handicapped parking permit.
- (2) No person to whom a permit has not been issued shall use a handicapped parking permit to park a motor vehicle in a designated handicapped parking space, except while transporting a handicapped person to whom such permit has been issued.

## § 126-18.3. Trailers. [Added 5-9-95 by L.L. 95-3 and Amended 11-13-2012 by L.L 2-2012]

A. Except as provided below, trailers, as defined in Section 156 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of this State as well as and including house trailers, mobile homes, boat trailers, semi-trailers, moving trailers, vending trailers, shall not be parked on any Village street, including public parking areas or private streets where parking is controlled by the Village, unless the trailer is at all times hitched to a vehicle.

- B. Exceptions. Trailers that are not hitched to a vehicle may be parked on any Village street under any of the following circumstances:
  - (1). When a permit to vend has been granted by the Village for the trailer;
  - (2). When such parking is done in conjunction with on-going construction for which permits are in place;
  - (3). When such parking is of a trailer providing seasonal or temporary transportation of recreational vehicles or equipment and notice of such parking has been provided in writing to the Village Clerk at least twenty-four hours in advance. This trailer can be left in place for no longer than forty-eight (48) hours.

# **ARTICLE IV Enforcement and Penalties**

## § 126-19. Enforcement by Police Department.

It shall be the duty of the Police Department to enforce the provisions of this Chapter.

# § 126-19.1. Removal of vehicles parked in prohibited areas. [Added 3-25-86 by L.L No. 1-1986]

Any authorized law enforcement official shall have the authority to remove and store any vehicle parked in prohibited or unauthorized areas or illegally parked during snowstorms, floods, fires or public emergencies or found unattended in areas where such vehicle constitutes an obstruction to traffic or where such parking is prohibited. Actual and reasonable charges for such removal and storage shall be paid by the owner or operator of any such vehicle so removed or stored. The sanctions imposed by this section shall be in addition to those authorized under Article IV, Enforcement and Penalties, of this Chapter.

## §126-20. Enforcement procedure.

All proceedings for enforcement and court proceedings shall be governed by the New York State Criminal Procedure Law and by the provisions of the Vehicle and Traffic Law.

### § 126-21. Traffic infractions.

It is a traffic infraction for any person to violate any of the provisions of this Chapter.

## § 126-22. Penalties for speeding violations.

Every person convicted of a violation of § 126-10 of this Chapter shall be punished by a fine and/or imprisonment as determined by New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law.

## § 126-23. Penalties for parking violations. [Amended 11-04-2009 by L. L. 2009-03]

- A. Parking offenses. The following fines will be authorized by the presiding Village Justice on the scheduled hearing date for a sole parking offense. Failure to appear to said hearing or failure to pay within the prescribed time frame established below shall result in an increased fine as authorized by the Village Justice on the scheduled hearing date in conformity with the table of fines set forth in this section:
  - (1) Where the sole offense charged is a parking offense, the person so charged shall have the option of appearing in the Village Court before the presiding Village Justice or may plead guilty to such offense by mail by remitting to the Court, on or before the return date on the ticket, the Official Village of Cold Spring traffic summons ticket together with the following fine set forth in Table 1 Column (A) of this section;
  - (2) Where the sole offense charged is a parking offense and the person so charged shall have failed to appear in the Village Court before the presiding Village Justice on the return day of the ticket or within thirty (30) days thereafter, then the person may plead guilty to such offense by mail by remitting to the Court, on or before sixty (60) days after the return date on the ticket, the Official Village of Cold Spring traffic summons ticket together with the fine established in Table 1 Column (B) of this section;
  - (3) Where the sole offense charged is a parking offense and the person so charged shall have failed to appear in the Village Court before the presiding Village Justice on the return day of the ticket or within sixty (60) days thereafter, then the person may plead guilty to such offense by mail by remitting to the Court, on or before ninety (90) days after the return date on the ticket, the Official Village of Cold Spring traffic summons ticket together with the fine established in Table 1 Column (C) of this section;

All fines must not exceed the maximum fine established in New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law, § 1800 (b).

B. Two (2) or More Violations. However, any person who shall have been convicted of two (2) or more violations of Article III of this Chapter within an eighteen-month (18 month) period shall not have the option of following the procedure set forth in Subsection A hereof but must appear before the Court, and such person, upon conviction, shall be subject to the imposition of a fine within the limits set forth in § 126-24 hereof.

## § 126-24. Additional penalty provisions.

- A. Every person convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this Chapter for which another penalty is not provided shall be punished by a fine or by imprisonment according to New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law. [Amended 4-27-99 by L.L. 1999-03]
- B. Failure to pay a fine as hereby provided or to appear in court voluntarily in answer or response to a ticket or summons will subject the operator or owner of such vehicle to a warrant for arrest and the imposition of such penalties as the law may provide.
- C. In addition to any other penalties or fines imposed for the violation of the Chapter, any authorized law enforcement official shall have authority to impound or to secure in place by means of a "boot" or similar detention device, any vehicle parked upon any public street in the Village of Cold Spring for which report has been made from the Village Justice Court to the Village Police Department that delinquent parking tickets totaling two hundred dollars (\$200) or more have been issued and have not been paid, satisfied, or otherwise disposed of. [Added 7-12-2011 by L.L. 2-2011]
- D. The owner of a vehicle removed by an authorized tow company shall be responsible to pay, in addition to the ticket issued by the Village of Cold Spring, the full amount charged by that tow company. [Added 7-12-2011 by L.L. 2-2011]
- E. The owner of a vehicle secured in place under § 126-24 C. shall be responsible for payment of the charges for securing of the vehicle, in the amount of fifty dollars (\$50), in addition to the delinquent parking tickets. [Added 7-12-2011 by L.L. 2-2011]
- F. Vehicles which are impounded or secured in place under § 126-24 C. and § 126-24 D. shall be retained in custody or shall be continually secured until such time that said tickets for violations as well as all removal and storage charges have been paid, satisfied, or otherwise disposed of. [Added 7-12-2011 by L.L. 2-2011]

# ARTICLE V Miscellaneous Provisions

§ 126-25. When effective.

- A. Except those parts, if any, which are subject to approval under § 1684 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York and § 46 of the Highway Law of the State of New York, this Chapter and any regulations adopted hereunder shall take effect as provided by law.
- B. Any part or parts of this Chapter and any regulations adopted hereunder which are subject to approval under § 1684 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law and § 46 of the Highway Law of the State of New York shall take effect from and after the day on which approval in writing is received from both the New York State Department of Transportation and the New York State Department of Public Works.

## § 126-26. Severability.

If any Article, section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or provision of this Chapter shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such adjudication shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the Article, section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or provision thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

## § 126-27. Repealer.

All prior laws, ordinances, regulations and rules or parts of such of this Village regulating traffic and parking, except Local Law No. 6 of 1977,<sup>3</sup> are hereby repealed, except that this repeal shall not affect or prevent the prosecution or punishment of any person for any act done or committed in violation of any ordinance, regulation or rule hereby repealed prior to the taking effect of this Chapter.

# § 126-41. Parking in Municipal Parking Lots. [Amended 4-12-2016 by L.L. 2-2016; 6-29-2021 by L.L 02-2021]

A. General. The Municipal Parking Lots (the "Lots") located on Fair Street are intended for the use of resident and visitor parking of licensed, registered and insured vehicles year round. No buses or campers are permitted due to the size limitations unless specifically permitted by the

Village Board.

- B. The Lots shall have outlined parking spaces numbered with appropriate signs, together with proper signage for the operation of the Mobile Parking Meter Application. The Mobile Parking Meter Application will accept credit cards, debit cards or other such payment method as may be designated by the Village Board.
- C. Fees. Any person desiring to park any vehicle within such Municipal Lots shall pay via the Mobile Parking Meter Application on their smart phone or by calling the toll free number shown on the signage and following the direction thereon for the time desired.
- D. Hours and days of operation. The Municipal Lots shall operate 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, except from November 15<sup>th</sup> through April 15<sup>th</sup> between the hours of 9 p.m. and 8 a.m. to allow for mandatory off-street parking during the winter months.
- E. Expired Parking. It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle or to permit a vehicle to remain parked in any Municipal Lots parking space without paying the proper payment heretofore designated or for longer than the period for which the proper payment was paid.
- F. Enforcement. The provisions of this section shall be enforced by the Police Department of the Village of Cold Spring pursuant to §126-19 of this Chapter.
